Set in Nazi Germany, a native Jewish family by the name of Fries (Free-ze), falsifies their ancestral records to protect themselves from the wrath of the Third Reich.

After taking over their family clothing business from their religiously shamed father MARCUS, the Fries Brothers, led by MAX and adopted son MORRIS, expand their enterprise within the growing nation. Betrayal from a long time employee's son turned Nazi, HELMUT SHULTZ, splits the family apart. Marcus gives his life so his wife ESTER and daughters HANKA and SOPHIE can escape the immediate Nazi invasion, as the eldest brother MARION avenges his fathers demise, while preserving the brothers cover.

The sisters and mother are forced to run and find safe haven in which to survive. The growing Nazi terror makes this near impossible in the next coming years, for the youngest, Sophie, is soon to find herself alone in a mortal hell.

The Brothers however can only grieve and hope that they are one day reunited with their loved ones. They continue to operate their chain of clothing/shoe stores, and even expand to opening a garment factory. Their labor force being comprised of Jewish Fugitives hidden underground. The Fries Brothers employ mercenaries to protect their hidden Jews. Mercenaries that are also evading the ranks of Hitler and the feared Russian front.

When Hanka is found dead in a hotel room along side a dead, newly appointed to the SS, Helmut Shultz, the beginning of the end is marked for the Fries Brothers run of good fortune. Nazi Detective Colonel HERMUN NATOR investigates and discovers the Fries's ultimate secret of Jewish faith, as he then takes down their underground organization, forcing the brothers to flee.

Sophie spends years with good natured German families, all of whom have fell victim to the Nazi regime in one fatal way or another. She almost makes it to the end of the war before her untimely capture sets her aboard a train to Aushwitz-Birkenau. Her terminal fate turns when the train is stopped and re-routed out of Germany. To her shocked surprise it is Sophie's *Brothers Fries*, that could not bare to allow their people to be sent to the gas chambers, whom have hijacked the train. After losing almost everything, but reuniting themselves and saving hundreds of their peoples lives, the Fries family voyages to America, where they, and their descendants, can live free to prosper.
